

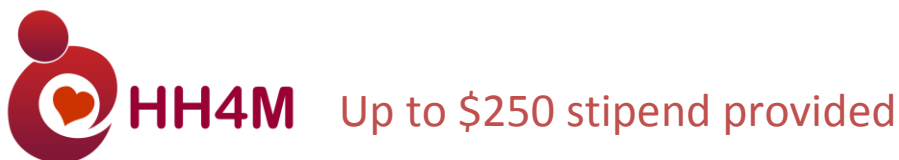
- ✓ Have you had a baby in the past 5 years?
